Whereas on October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010, the Carleton University Board of Governors passed a motion to withhold the membership fees of the Carleton University Students' Association (CUSA) and the Carleton University Graduate Students'

Association (GSA) until the student associations signed a new fee and governance agreement with their University Administration; and

Whereas the proposed fee agreement would obligate both student associations to provide the Carleton Administration with annual financial statements, and would grant the Administration the sole authority to accept those financial statements, override the democratic will of students to collect new levies, and remove the students associations from their existing office space with only three months' notice; and

Whereas both student associations are autonomous, incorporated organizations that are accountable to the students of Carleton University and not their University Administration, and, accordingly, have undergone annual external audits that are available to any member of the unions; and

Whereas the Carleton Administration's demand to control the finances and space of the students' associations, as well as its leveraging strategy both constitute violations of student union autonomy; and

Whereas the Carleton Administration's refusal to remit membership fees has jeopardized continued access to several clubs, societies, and services which are paid for by Carleton students; and

Whereas both the Canadian Federation of Students and the Canadian Association of University Teachers have sent similar letters to support CUSA and the GSA; therefore
